Items Discussed:
[Redacted] called regarding his mother's house located at [Redacted]
His mother's name is [Redacted]
[Redacted] confirmed that [Redacted] is south of the existing I-80
I explained the roadway was being realigned to the north and the existing bridge would be removed. There will be no changes in the local street network.
[Redacted] observed the change would further diminish the community, compounding the effects from the original construction of I-80. He indicated his mother's home was one of only five left on [Redacted]. He inquired if the existing structure could be removed without endangering the homes immediately adjacent as they are quite close to the bridge.
I indicated that the intent was to remove the bridge utilizing only the existing roadway property. He expressed concern that construction noise and debris will impact the home.
He asked if the department ever considers acquiring property adjacent to construction activities. I indicated department policy requires that the minimum property necessary to execute the improvement be acquired.
I encouraged him to attend the meeting with his mother to provide us their input.

Dear REDACTED ,

Thank you for your inquiry and we apologize if you found the map confusing. The proposed improvement includes constructing a new bridge to carry I-80 over the Des Plaines River. Due to the truss type of the existing bridge, it cannot be widened. To ensure operational and roadway standards are met, I-80 will be shifted to the north at the Des Plaines River. Therefore, the new bridge is north of the existing bridge. Once the new bridge is constructed, the old bridge will be removed and the area under it will be fenced.

The address REDACTED in Joliet, is located between the existing bridge and the new bridge. At this time, the proposed improvement does not anticipate acquiring properties on the south side of Duncan Street between Kiep Street and River Street including the property at REDACTED

The proposed improvement anticipates the potential acquisition of properties on the north side of Duncan Street from River Street to Des Plaines Street as well as the properties on the south side of Duncan Street from Kiep Street to Water Street. See page 1 of the attached exhibits where the properties to be potentially acquired are shaded in gold. We have also indicated the location of REDACTED on the attached exhibits.

We encourage you and your neighbors to attend the meeting on June 11, 2019 at the Harvey Brooks Foundation Family Life Center at 503 Water Street in Joliet. It is an open house format so you can come by any time between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM to talk to the project design team and review additional exhibits.
